Wuyuan, known as the "most beautiful countryside in China," with at least 50 old villages, is located northeast of Jiangxi Province, and near Mt Huangshan and Jingdezhen. Wuyuan is home to a few of the well-preserved ancient architecture in China. Each of those ancient structures has a unique appearance as well as structure. They emerge from among the emerald green mountains and trees, clear rivers along with the crisscrossing paths between the fields.



Huangling Village, it is like a pearl embraced by Shier Mountain. This village is full of an atmosphere of simplicity and elegance. It features cable transport, ancient residences, terraces, ocean of flowers, and folk customs. Built on a hillside, houses in Huangling Village have a unique characteristic "U" shape. In the autumn of each year, villagers dry crops in order to preserve their year's produce.



Mount Longhu, aka Dragon and Tiger Mountain, is a famous Taoism mountain with a long history. 16 km (about 9.94 miles) south of Yingtan City, Jiangxi Province, it has been noted as the 'Residence of Celestials' and 'Blest Earthly Abode' because of its beautiful scenery. As a cradle land of Taoism, Mount Longhu has been regarded as a Holy Land to which many pilgrimages are made every year.



Mount Gexian, one of the most ancient mount in China, has a long history and deep cultural roots. It is full of historical sites and cultural relics associated with numerous legends. The Gexian Ancestral Temple, also known as Yuxu Temple, is the largest Taoist temple on the mountain. The original temple named "Zonghua Temple" dates back to the 9th century during the Tang dynasty (618-907). In 1065, Emperor Yingzong of Song inscribed and honored the name "Yuxu Temple".



Wangxian Valley is a newly developing scenic spot located in Jiangxi Province, China. It is famous for its houses hanging from the cliff, which are an imitation of an ancient city with streets and buildings. The valley is based on the Ganjia culture, with authentic Ganjia-style architecture and folk customs. There is an artificial waterfall in the valley, and the Han wedding with gongs and drums, red makeup for ten miles, and folk performances with loud voices complement each other in the valley.
