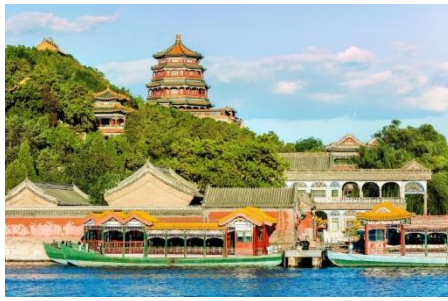
The Forbidden City was the palatial heart of China. It is an imperial palace complex of the Ming and Qing dynasties (1368–1912) in Beijing, China. As one of the five most important palaces in the world, the grand halls and walls proudly display the essence and culmination of traditional Chinese architecture, fitting for the capital city of the world's largest nation.



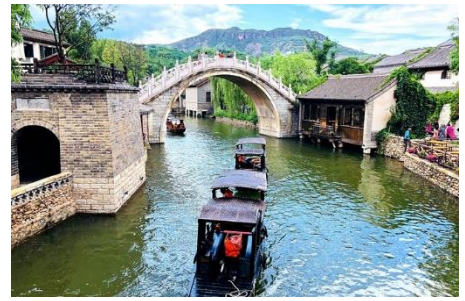
Juyongguan Great Wall is located in the northwestern part of Changping County, about 60 kilometers away from central Beijing (Tian'anmen Square). It is the closest section of Great Wall to downtown Beijing. Keep heading northwest about 15km, and then you will get to Badaling section of the Great Wall. Juyong Pass is a very important place connecting the capital Beijing and the northern border of China.



As the largest of Beijing's imperial of religious building complexes, the **Temple of Heaven** is known for its rigorous symbolic layout, peculiar structure, and magnificent decoration. It is the most representative example of Chinese ritual architecture. Emperors of the Ming and Qing dynasties (from 1420 to 1900) worshiped the god of heaven and prayed for good harvests there. The Temple of Heaven is located south of the Forbidden City. The total area of Temple of Heaven Park is about 2.73 km² (1.05 sq mi).



Situated in the Haidian District northwest of Beijing, **Summer Palace** is 15 kilometers (9 miles) from the downtown area. Being the largest and most well-preserved royal park in China, it greatly influences Chinese horticulture and landscape with its famous natural views and cultural interests, which also has long been recognized as 'The Museum of Royal Gardens'. Yiheyuan radiates fully the natural beauty and the grandeur of royal gardens. Composed mainly of Longevity Hill and Kunming Lake, it owns over 3,000 man-made ancient structures, including pavilions, towers, bridges, corridors, etc.



Situated in Gubeikou Town of Miyun County in Beijing, **Gubei Water Town** surrounds the beautiful Mandarin Duck Lake Reservoir and leans against the Simatai Great Wall, the most dangerous and majestic section of the entire Great Wall. Regarded as 'Wuzhen in Beijing', Gubei Water Town boasts a combination of mountains, water and ancient villages. It is not a historical water town, it is a replica of Wuzhen Water Town in the Southern China, has developed into a large-scale sightseeing and holiday destination.
