

Pass through the route using six different modes of transportation, including cable cars and aerial tramways. As you traverse the landscape, you'll be able to take in stunning views of Japan's Northern Alps.
- ✓ Sensoji, the oldest temple in Japan's capital, is located in Asakusa, Tokyo's most popular sightseeing area.
- ✓ Shirakawa-go is a village of gassho-zukuri style Japanese houses in Gifu Prefecture that is listed as a World Heritage site.

The construction of *Osaka Castle* started in 1583 on the former site of the Ishiyama Honganji Temple, which had been destroyed by Oda Nobunaga thirteen years earlier. Toyotomi Hideyoshi intended the castle to become the center of a new, unified Japan under Toyotomi rule. It was the largest castle at the time.



Kiyomizudera is one of the most celebrated temples of Japan. It was founded in 780 on the site of the Otowa Waterfall in the wooded hills east of Kyoto, and derives its name from the fall's pure waters. The temple was originally associated with the Hosso sect , one of the oldest schools within Japanese Buddhism, but formed its own Kita Hosso sect in 1965. In 1994, the temple was added to the list of UNESCO world heritage sites.



Oshino Hakkai is a touristy set of eight ponds in Oshino, a small village in the Fuji Five Lake region, located between Lake Kawaguchiko and Lake Yamanakako on the site of a former sixth lake that dried out several hundred years ago. The eight ponds are fed by snow melt from the slopes of nearby Mount Fuji that filters down the mountain through porous layers of lava for over 80 years, resulting in very clear spring water that is revered by the locals.



Sensoji is a Buddhist temple located in Asakusa. It is one of Tokyo's most colorful and popular temples. The legend says that in the year 628, two brothers fished a statue of Kannon, the goddess of mercy, out of the Sumida River, and even though they put the statue back into the river, it always returned to them. Consequently, Sensoji was built nearby for the goddess of Kannon. The temple was completed in 645, making it Tokyo's oldest temple.



The *Shirakawa-go* and neighboring Gokayama regions line the Shogawa River Valley in the remote mountains that span from Gifu to Toyama Prefectures. Declared a UNESCO world heritage site in 1995, they are famous for their traditional gasshozukuri farmhouses, some of which are more than 250 years old. Gassho-zukuri means "constructed like hands in prayer", as the farmhouses' steep thatched roofs resemble the hands of Buddhist monks pressed together in prayer.

Itinerary

- Day 1 Kuala Lumpur Osaka Kansai
- Day 2 Arrive in Osaka ~ Osaka Castle / Kyoto (about 1.5 hrs) ~ Fushimi Inari Shrine ~ Kinkakuji (Golden Pavilion) / Gifu (about 2.5hrs) **Fushimi Inari Shrine is an important Shinto shrine in southern Kyoto. It is famous for its thousands of vermilion torii gates, which straddle a network of trails behind its main buildings. The trails lead into the wooded forest of the sacred Mount Inari, which stands at 233 meters and belongs to the shrine grounds.
- Day 3 Gifu / Shirakawa-go Gassho Zukuri Folk Village (about 2.5 hrs) / Takayama (about 45 mins) ~ Takayama Old Streets / Kanazawa (about 2.5 hrs)
- Day 4 Kanazawa / Tateyama Kurobe Alpine (Ticket included, about 2 hrs) / Azumino (about 1 hrs)

 **The Tateyama Kurobe Alpine Route is a unique and spectacular route through the Northern Japan Alps which is traversed by various means of transportation including cablecars, trolley buses and a ropeway. Completed in 1971, the route connects Toyama City in Toyama Prefecture with Omachi Town in Nagano Prefecture. The section between Tateyama Station and Ogizawa is closed to private vehicles.
- Day 5 Azumino / Mount Fuji Area (about 2.5 hrs) ~ Oshino Hakkai ~ Mt Fuji 5th Station ~ Earthquake Simulation Centre ~ Oishi Park
- Day 6 Hot Spring Hotel / Tokyo (about 2.5 hrs) ~ Shinjuku ~ Sensoji Temple ~ Kaminarimon ~ Nakamise Street ~ Tokyo Skytree (outside view) ~ Odaiba Gundam Statue
 - **Gundam fans and everyone else, rejoice. Odaiba's much-loved full-scale replica Gundam is back even bigger and better than before. Say hello to the RX-0 Unicorn Gundam replica from the Mobile Suit Gundam Unicorn series. Parked in front of DiverCity Tokyo Plaza, the new life-sized Gundam statue now towers over spectators at a staggering height of 19.7 metres.
