第1天 吉隆坡 - 大阪日本 (机上用餐)

集合于吉隆坡国际机场，飞往大阪关西机场

第2天 大阪 - 奈良 (约1.5小时) (午/晚)

抵达大阪关西机场，前往游览

- 奈良公园 ~ 与温顺的鹿零距离接触
- 东大寺 ~ 内有卢舍那大佛,世界上最大的青铜佛像
- 大阪城公园 ~ 日本大阪市中心的公园，以大阪城为中心，是大阪市的地标之一，一年四季风景各异
- 心斋桥 ~ 大阪最著名的购物和娱乐区域之一.拱廊式购物街,各种商店，包括奢侈品牌、药妆店、潮流服饰店和传统手工艺品商店
- 道顿堀 ~ 大阪非常著名的繁华商业和娱乐区，以其五光十色的霓虹灯招牌、活力四射的氛围以及丰富的美食文化闻名于世

第3天 大阪 - 京都 (约1.5小时) - 岐阜 (早/午/晚)

早餐后，前往京都. 游览

- 清水寺(含门票) ~ 是京都最古老的寺院，与金阁寺、二条城并称为京都三大名胜，1994年列入世界文化遗产名录
- 二年坂&三年坂 ~ 古老街道两侧有着许多历史悠久的建筑和商店. 体验京都传统文化
- 伏见稻荷大社/千本鸟居 ~ 京都最著名的景点之一.大社的主要建筑早在1499年建成，用以供奉神道界中一位重要的神祇—稻荷神（谷物、食物之神）

前往岐阜 (约2.5小时) . 抵达后, 入住酒店

第4天 白川乡 - 安昙野市 (约2.5小时) (早/午/晚)

早餐后, 游览白川乡合掌村

位于日本岐阜县的传统村落 - 最著名的合掌村,已经被联合国教科文组织列为世界文化遗产. 这些村落以“合掌造”建筑风格著称.合掌造是一种具有特色的日本传统建筑形式,屋顶陡峭如双手合掌,形似合掌的样子,屋顶设计旨在适应积雪气候,能够快速滑落积雪,防止屋项塌.合掌村仍保留了许多传统的农耕生活和手工艺品制作,游客可参观村中的作坊、老式木屋,感受日本古老的乡村氛围.

高山古镇 ~ 岐阜县著名的旅游景点,至今依然保留着江户时代的旧街景.小镇上林立着一间间古色古香的老店.街上挂满着古老韵味的暖帘等,充满日本原始风光的迷人街景

第5天 安昙野市 - 富山 (约2.5小时) (早/午/晚)

早餐后，前往富山. 游览

- 忍野八海 ~ 忍野八海以其清澈的泉水和美丽的自然景观而闻.忍野八海的八个池塘在火山喷发以及强烈火山运动后形成.多个池塘的水源是来自地下涌泉,并以富含矿物质的泉水而闻名.涌池的池水极清澈干净并列为全国最优质泉水之一
- 新仓山浅间公园 ~ 景色优美的新仓山浅间公园,将远方富士山的壮丽山景尽收眼底
- 河口湖 (船游) ~ 位于日本‘富士山’山麓，拥有美丽的湖景及美丽(视当天天气情况而定) 的大自然

第6天 富山 - 东京 (约2小时) (早/午/晚)

早餐后，前往东京. 游览

- 浅草寺 & 仲见世商店街 ~ 日本东京最著名、最古老的寺庙之一 亦是东京的重要文化和历史地标之一.浅草寺的标志性大门‘雷门’.一路两旁的商店里摆满了独特的纪念品和传统小吃
- 晴空塔 (远观) ~ 一座高634m 是世界上最高的自立式塔
- 银座大道 ~ 东京最具代表性的繁华商圈，汇集许多高档百货店
- 新宿大道 ~ 一个充满活力的都市街道，不仅是购物、娱乐和餐饮的集中地，还是体验东京现代都市文化的好地方

Day 1 Kuala Lumpur - Kansai/Osaka (MOB)

Assemble at KLIA. Depart to Kansai Airport by flight

DAY 2 Osaka - Nara (about 1.5 hour) (L/D)

Arrival Kansai Airport. Transfer to Nara

- Nara Park** ~Magnificent temples and shrines and wild-roaming deer in a huge park
- Tōdaiji** ~ The Great Buddha of Nara and Historic Temple Complex
- Osaka Castle Park** ~ A large public park in the heart of Osaka, surrounding the historic Osaka Castle. The park is a popular destination for both tourists & locals, offering a blend of natural beauty, cultural history & recreational spaces
- Shinsaibashi-suji Street & Dotonbori** ~The best-known shopping area in Osaka, and an enduring symbol of the city

DAY 3 Osaka - Kyoto (about 1.5 hour) - Gifu (B/L/D)

After breakfast, heading to Kyoto. Visit

- Kiyomizu-dera** ~one of Japan's most famous and historic temples. It is renowned for its wooden stage that juts out from the main hall, offering visitors breathtaking views of the cherry and maple trees below, as well as a panoramic view of Kyoto.
- Ninen Zaka & Sannen Zaka** ~The old cobblestone streets of Ninenzaka, and Sannenzaka have prospered since ancient times. These sloping streets are lined with historic Japanese-style buildings that typify Kyoto, even including many souvenir shops.
- Fushimi Inari Taisha/Senbon Torii** ~ one of the most iconic and significant Shinto shrines in Japan. It is dedicated to Inari, the Shinto god of rice, fertility, and business prosperity.

Depart to Gifu.(about 2.5 hour) Upon arrival, check in hotel.

DAY 4 Shirakawa-go - Azumino (about 2.5 hour) (B/L/D)

After breakfast, visit Shirakawa-go Gassho-zukuri Village

~Shirakawa-go is a historic village renowned for its traditional Gassho-zukuri architecture. This area is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, with its unique steeply thatched-roof houses designed to withstand heavy snowfalls and provide space for silk farming. It is known as a village where people are live their lives and continuing existence the traditional way of life. In addition, there are many sightseeing spots around where you can experience the traditional wisdom and skills , and the magnificent nature that you should visit

Takayama Old Town

~ a beautifully preserved historical town known for its Edo-period architecture, rich culture, and charming atmosphere. Often referred to as "Little Kyoto," Takayama offers visitors a glimpse into traditional Japanese life and craftsmanship.

DAY 5 Azumino - Fuji (about 2.5 hour) (B/L/D)

After breakfast, proceed to Fuji. Visit

- Oshino Hakkai** ~ a picturesque village located near Mount Fuji in Yamanashi Prefecture. Famous for its crystal-clear ponds fed by snowmelt from Mount Fuji, it is a serene destination offering natural beauty, cultural significance, and a peaceful atmosphere. The name "Hakkai" translates to "Eight Seas," referring to the eight ponds in the area
- Arakuyama Sengen Park** ~ is known as one of the best spots to see Mt. Fuji, a beautiful five-story pagoda
- Lake Kawaguchiko-sightseeing boat** (Subject to the weather conditions of the day)
~You can enjoy the magnificent Mt. Fuji and the panoramic 360-degree view

Day 6 Fuji - Tokyo (about 2 hour) (B/L/D)

After breakfast, proceed to Tokyo. Visit

- Sensoji Temple & Nakamise Street** ~one of the Japan's oldest and most famous Buddhist temples. Built in 628 AD, it is dedicated to Kannon, the Buddhist goddess of mercy. The temple attracts millions of visitors annually and is a symbol of Tokyo's rich history and culture. This bustling street is lined with shops selling traditional snacks, souvenirs, and crafts, offering a glimpse of Japan's vibrant culture.
- Tokyo Skytree (overlook)** ~one of the tallest structures in the world and a prominent landmark in Tokyo
- Ginza Avenue** ~Tokyo's most famous shopping streets, which is often considered the heart of luxury shopping and a symbol of Tokyo's modern sophistication
- Shinjuku Avenue** ~Tokyo's most vibrant and bustling areas, offering a mix of shopping, entertainment, dining, and cultural experiences
